



Here is a guide to coming to see us!

By tube, there are two routes. 1. **Hammersmith**, Zone 2 (Piccadilly, District, Circle and Hammersmith and City Lines). Take the short walk from the station over Hammersmith Bridge (currently, the bridge is closed to vehicles, so walking is the only option)* Once over the bridge either jump on an e-scooter or bike, one of the many buses (533, 33, 419, 209, 485) or take a stroll down Castelnau. Whichever way you choose to get to us from Hammersmith Bridge will take under 10 mins.

Putney Bridge, Zone 2 (District Line). Jump on the 378 from Putney Bridge Station (stop FE) to Mortlake, getting off at the Red Lion bus stop. It's a 10 minute trip. Olympic Studios is directly opposite the bus stop. If you fancy a 15-minute stroll along the River, you can walk from Putney Bridge Station, along the tow path, turning left at the Wetlands Centre.

By train (South West Trains) from all stations on the Waterloo main line. From Waterloo is under 20 minutes; Clapham Junction under 10 minutes and the trains are very frequent (every 10 minutes usually). You can tap in and out, so you don't need to buy a ticket. Get the train to Barnes or Barnes Bridge – both are only a 5-minute walk to Olympic.

By bike. There are lots of lovely cycle routes to Barnes. Currently, you can walk your bike over Hammersmith Bridge (no, we don't know why you must jump off and walk it over either but soon it will be back to cycling over it again apparently!). You can also cycle along various river routes. We have bike parking.

By car. After midday there are many surrounding roads that offer free parking. 2 hours is under £3 for pay and display.

Google doesn't seem to understand the concept of walking over bridges, so it can send you on a wild, wiggly route just to avoid Hammersmith Bridge. So, hopefully the above makes it easy to understand how best to get to us. If you still have questions though, please don't hesitate to get in touch.
